

POSITION OPENING Director of Children's Ministry (Maternity Leave Cover)*

Ministry Goal

Lead, develop and manage a vibrant Children's Ministry which equips and enables ministry leaders and parents to missionally disciple children towards maturity in Jesus Christ.

Responsibilities

Provide overall leadership and management of Children's Ministries, working especially with leaders of various programs. Specific responsibilities include:

- 1. Recruit, develop and oversee a network of spiritually gifted volunteer leaders who reach-out toward children and disciple them effectively.
- 2. Oversee all programs related to children with a particular emphasis on Sunday School.
 - a. Train and resource leaders for effective ministry to children.
 - b. Develop personal relationships with leaders providing feedback and encouragement.
 - c. Provide an emotionally and physically safe environment for children as outlined in the church's child safety policies.
 - d. Research and select (or develop) curriculum appropriate for the learning goals of each age level.
- 3. Equip and support parents as the primary disciplers of children (i.e. Milestones Program).
- 4. Oversee outreach to children and families in Cochrane, including but not limited to
 - a. Summer outreach programming (i.e. Backyard Bible Camps, Soccer Camp)
 - b. Outreach to Families (i.e. "Moms and Tots)
- 5. Periodically review and reshape the ministry to foster health and to align with the mission and vision of Cochrane Alliance Church.
- 6. Provide supervision to summer interns.
- 7. Participate as a contributing member of the staff team.

Work Conditions

This will be a part-time (25 hrs/week) one-year contract position to cover a maternity leave commencing April 23, 2017. The successful candidate and their supervisor will create a customized work-schedule. Weekend and/or evening hours will be required.
