

¹The words of the Teacher, son of David, king in Jerusalem:


² "Meaningless! Meaningless!" says the Teacher.



"When the word is used metaphorically, it emphasises the elusiveness of human existence. Human life is hevel because it is impermanent, because we change and ultimately die.

"When Solomon describes "everything" as vapour, he is ...
highlighting the elusiveness of the world, which slips through
our fingers and escapes all our efforts to manage it.
He is pointing to the brevity of life, and
everything in it, which dissolves as quickly

as the mist in the morning."




Ecclesiastes 1:8-11





- is a result of the fall




Romans 8:18-20


in hope that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the children of God.


