A Temple in which God Lives

What <u>WE</u> are because of Jesus.

Together, we are his house, built on the foundation of the apostles and the prophets. And the cornerstone is Christ Jesus himself. We are carefully joined together in him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord. Through him you Gentiles are also being made part of this dwelling where God lives by his Spirit.

Verse 20-22

A Temple in which God Lives

What <u>WE</u> are because of Jesus.

What is the purpose of the new temple? In principle, it is the same as the purpose of the old, namely to be a dwelling place of God... The new temple, however, is neither a material building, nor a national shrine, nor has it a localized site.

It is a spiritual building (God's household) and an international community (embracing Gentiles as well as Jews), and it has a worldwide spread (wherever God's people are to be found). This is where God dwells. He is not tied to holy buildings but to holy people, He lives in them, individually and as a community.


What <u>WE</u> are because of Jesus.

Don't forget that you Gentiles used to be outsiders. You were called "uncircumcised heathens" by the Jews...You were excluded from citizenship among the people of Israel, and you did not know the covenant promises God had made to them.

Verse 11-12

The Jew had an immense contempt for the Gentile. The Gentiles, said the Jews, were created by God to be fuel for the fires of hell. God, they said, loves only Israel of all the nations that he had made ... It was not even lawful to render help to a Gentile mother in her hour of sorest need, for that would simply be to bring another Gentile into the world. Until Christ came, the Gentiles were an object of contempt to the Jews. The barrier between them was absolute.
