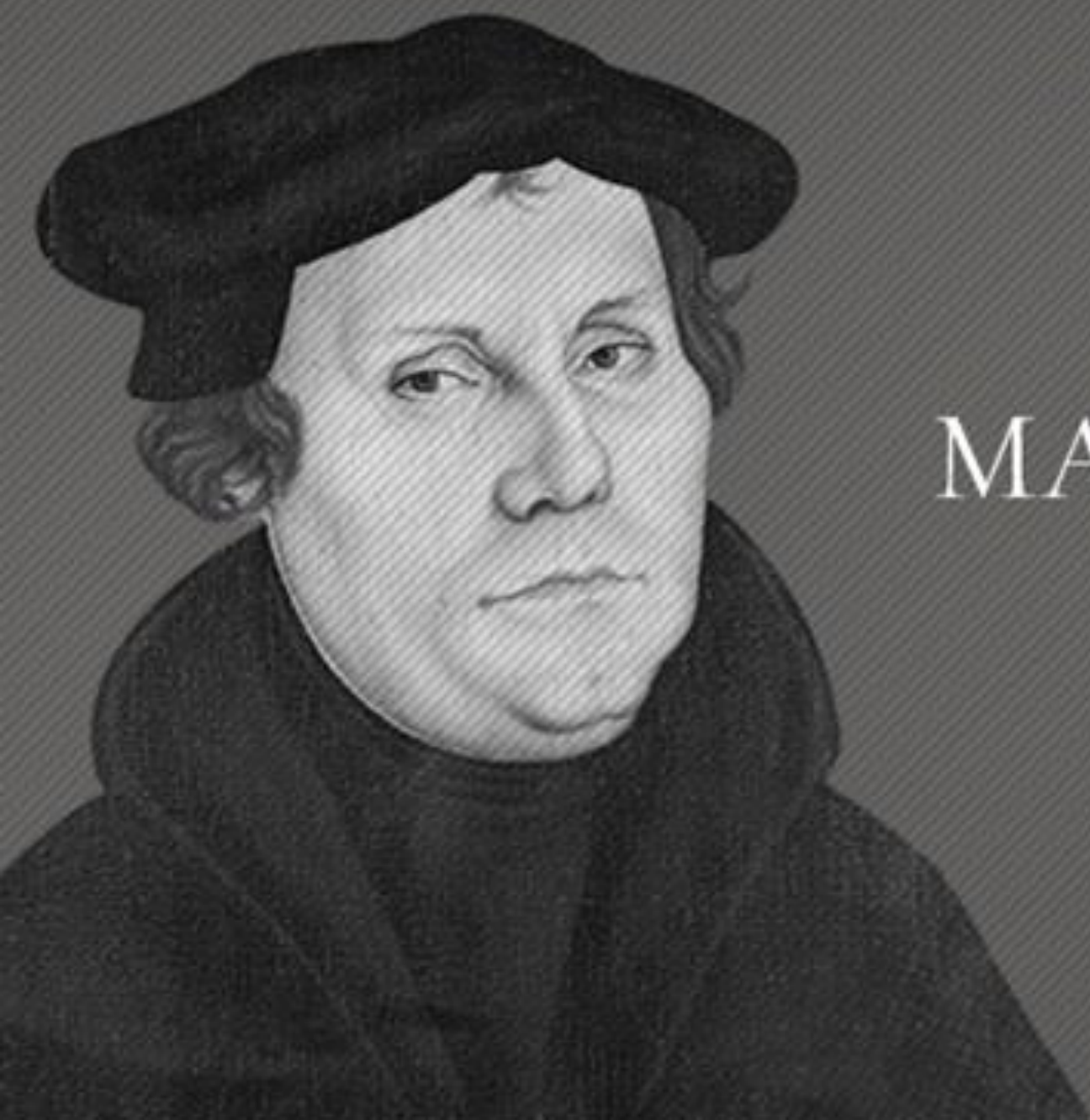

**Titus 2:11-14** – For the grace of God has appeared bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Saviour Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.





**Titus 3:1** – Remind them to be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient to be ready for every good work.

**Titus 3:8** – Be careful to devote themselves to good works

# 1) Rescues us from Sin and Captivity

Mark 10:45 – For the Son of man came not to be served but to give His life as a ransom for many.





2) Cleans us and makes us His

2 Corinthians 5:21 – For our sake he made himself to be sin, who knew no sin, that we might become the righteousness of God.





### 3) He makes us Zealous for Good Works

Zealous – enthusiastic, one who has deep feelings or attitudes of deep commitment to a person or cause.



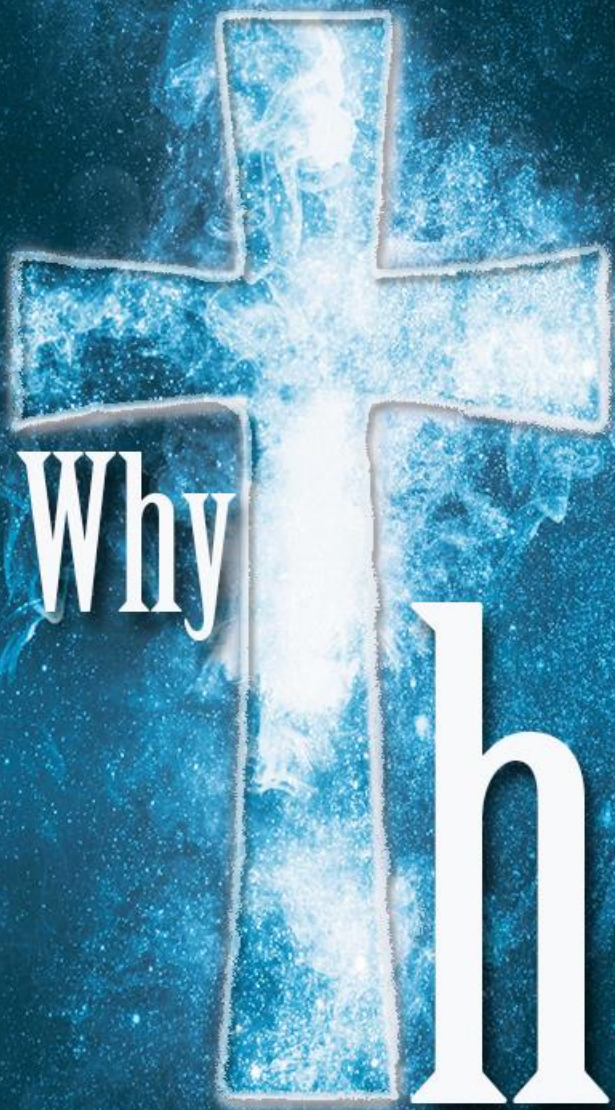
