# Relationships

- 2. Camp Ministry
  - a. Assist in the development and implementation of summer day camp ministries for children ages 4-12 (Backyard Kids Camp and Soccer Camp)
  - b. Assist in the follow-up of children/families who attend the camps
- 3. Oversight of volunteers
  - a. Recruit, equip and oversee weekend volunteers for July & August
  - b. Assist with recruitment, scheduling and communication camp volunteer team
- 4. Administration
  - a. Assist Children's Pastor in ensuring the practices and policies of Plan to Protect are in place for Children's Ministries
  - b. Assist as needed in areas of general church ministry
