






## DUMB IDEA #1

God is merciful, so he uses storms to correct and mature us.





#### BETTER IDEA #2


God pours out common grace on all teams. Therefore other teams have something to teach us.

A remarkable thing about even the active Christian is that he never has much more than a vague idea about reality. He views the storm from outside, not as one who is in the boat, even if his intentions are good.
