Role

Duration & Salary

Relationships

The Summer Coordinator reports to the Children's Pastor as the primary point of mentorship and accountability. The Summer Coordinator will build relationships with children, parents and volunteers and will function as a ministry leader in the church.

Responsibilities

- 1. Sunday Weekend Ministry
 - a. Oversee the planning and implementation of summer Sunday curriculum for PS/K children (videos, resources, onsite materials, set up, etc).
 - b. Assist with communication of weekend programs to families and volunteers (videos, social media, email communication, etc).
- 2. Camp Ministry
 - a. Assist in the development and implementation of Kids Camps (Backyard Kids Camp and Soccer Camp).
 - b. Leadership involvement in Soccer Camp.
- 3. Oversight of Volunteers
 - a. Assist with recruitment, equipping and oversight of volunteers to help prepare, deliver and facilitate programs (Sunday School and Weekday Programs).

- 4. Fall Ministry Prep
 - a. Assist in preparation of Curriculum for new ministry year.
 - b. Assist with Volunteer Safe Kids training resources and administration for new church year.

Qualifications

- The applicant must be between the ages of 15-30
- The applicant must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
- Leadership Skills ability to connect effectively with children and parents. Team oriented and proven record of establishing trust and respect from others. Self-motivated and reliable.
