Immerse in the Story

Pick a story about Jesus in the gospels. Read the story once and choose a character in the story (other than Jesus) that you want to experience. Now listen to the story through an Audio Bible and picture yourself as the character in the story. How do you feel? What would it be like to experience Jesus in the way that this character did? What is Jesus saying to you through this activity?

Stories to start with: John 6:1-15, Matthew 14:22-32, John 13:1-17, Matthew 9:18-26, Luke 4:31-36, John 8:1-11

Read & Reflect

Read a small passage of scripture once to explore. Reflect on it. Read it again slowly to really understand what it is saying. Reflect. Read it again, paying attention to what it says about who God is. Reflect. Read it again, this time highlighting all of the verbs. Reflect. Read it again, asking God what He wants to speak to you. Reflect. Feel free to read it through as many times as you like, looking for different things each time!
